Rivermead Primary School's Working at Expected level was higher than National and in-line with Wokingham. However, Wokingham surpassed Rivermead in the Greater Depth category.

Writing

Rivermead Primary School's performance in Writing was in-line with both Wokingham and National averages in both EXS+ and GDS, highlighting strong writing outcomes.

Maths

Rivermead Primary School performed significantly better than both Wokingham and National in Working at Expected, and surpassed both in Greater Depth. These results highlight very strong outcomes in maths for Rivermead.

GPS (Grammar, Punctuation, and Spelling)

Rivermead Primary School achieved higher outcomes than both National and Wokingham in Working at Expected and at the Greater Depth level.
